

MAINTENANCE PLAN GUIDE

TAKE CARE OF YOUR VEHICLE'S WEAR-AND-TEAR AND SERVICE ITEMS IN ONE GO

The Maintenance Plan runs for a set period of time (e.g. 3 years) or for a fixed number of kilometres (e.g. 45 000 km), whichever happens first. To ensure your plan stays intact, service your vehicle as per your car manufacturer's specifications.

WHAT IS A MAINTENANCE PLAN?

This plan provides for the replacement, maintenance and repairs for specific wear-and-tear parts, including wiper blades and brake pads. All maintenance repairs must be performed by an approved servicing workshop, for a specific period of time or specific distance travelled - whichever happens first.

This Maintenance Plan offers you convenient payment options so that you spend less time worrying about the costs of taking care of your vehicle and more time enjoying the open road.

This Maintenance Plan is not a Warranty. A warranty provides for major unexpected mechanical breakdowns and electrical failures like engine or gearbox failure. Maintenance plan upgrades do not pay for services provided for by your OEM plan or current existing plans.

WHAT IS WEAR-AND-TEAR?

Wear-and-tear is a term used to describe the gradual physical deterioration of various parts of the vehicle. Wear-and-tear happens naturally and is inevitable as a result of normal use and ageing.

HOW DO YOU BENEFIT?

This plan will service and repair

- Only qualified technicians who use genuine parts will service your vehicle
- Affordable payment options to avoid paying large amounts at once
- The financial institution that finances your vehicle may be able to incorporate the payments for your plan into your monthly vehicle instalment

WHAT DOES A MAINTENANCE PLAN PROVIDE FOR?*

- V-Belts (replaced when deemed necessary by the approval facility)
- Front & rear brake pads/drums/discs
- Front & rear shock absorbers
- Rear wheel cylinders
- Clutch & clutch components
- Factory-fitted default fuses & globes (excl. any upgrades - xenon and sealed units)
- Alternator
- Air conditioner
- CV joints and boots
- Differential unit
- Engine
- Fuel system
- Transmission/gearbox
- Turbo assembly (sealed units)
- Wheel bearings
- Steering components



YOUR CAR QUALIFIES FOR A MAINTENANCE PLAN IF IT

- Has travelled less than 80 000 km
- Is less than 4 years old (calculated from the date of first registration)
- Has a valid Manufacturer Warranty
- Has a full service history as per the required frequency and specifications - done by an approved servicing workshop
